Requests for financial aid must come directly from the player's parents or legal guardians. All completed financial aid requests must be mailed to:

Eligibility is based upon a player's acceptance into his/her school's free or reduced lunch program as determined by the Federal Poverty Guidelines. No financial information is required other than the completed **Free or Reduced Price Meals Verification Form** (page 3) and a copy of the free meal notification letter to family. Parents will complete the **Free or Reduced Price Meals Verification Form** and submit with this form. Once you received your letter from the Free or Reduced Meals plan you must present a copy of this to the HWSC. Those receiving free or reduced meals are eligible for 100% financial aid (minus the minimum payments required).

Homewood Soccer Club recognizes that unforeseen circumstances may occur which can impact a family's ability to pay. Therefore if you do not meet the requirements of the Free or Reduced meals you may call our office and speak to the office Manager 874-9182 to be considered for FA. A financial aid committee exists to review individual cases, should the need arise. You may be asked to provide documentation relating to the financial aid request and may be required to meet with the financial committee to determine eligibility. Each request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

Parents applying for FINANCIAL AID should come to a registration day or register at the office register. If possible please mail in your documents prior to your registration.

To ensure privacy, all financial aid requests will be held in the strictest of confidence by the Homewood Soccer Club Tuition Assistance Committee and the Homewood Soccer Board.

Applying for financial aid does not automatically guarantee that the player will receive either full or partial aid. The Tuition Assistance Committee will review all requests and submitted paperwork and the office manager will notify applicants to let you know if you qualify by mail or email prior to the start of the soccer season.

Families will apply for financial aid once during the soccer year. Therefore, applications made for Fall financial aid will encompass both the fall and spring soccer seasons (2014-2015 school year). **However a payment plan must be filled out at the beginning of each season and turned into the soccer office, to let us know how the player will pay.**
